# TEAM REGISTRATION

Headquarters will be open on Thursday evening from 7:00-9:00PM and then again on Friday at 6:45AM

A team representative must register at Iroquois Park Sports Centre prior to the team's first game. We <u>must</u> confirm your attendance, we <u>must</u> view your most up-to-date OWHA OFFICIAL TEAM ROSTER (not waiver) or USA Hockey Roster (even if you sent same via email), and we <u>must</u> obtain any player pick up forms (even if you sent same via email).

In the event the team's first game is between 8am-11am on Friday at an arena other than Iroquois Park Sports Centre, those teams will be permitted to register **immediately** after their first game, **provided** no pick up players are being utilized in the tournament.

# TOURNAMENT PASSPORT

When your team registers at Iroquois Park Sports Centre, you will be provided with a Tournament Passport. You <u>MUST</u> show this Tournament Passport if you are making any changes to the pre-printed game sheets or labels for semi-final and finals games (Exception: Jersey number changes). Only the people listed on the Tournament Passport are authorized to participate in the game as a player, goalie or bench staff. If unauthorized names are found on any game sheets, the team will be reported to the OWHA for having an illegal participant.

### NECK GUARDS/MOUTH GUARDS

Mandatory neck guards are required as per Hockey Canada for Ontario teams. Mandatory mouth guards are required as per USA Hockey for US teams.

#### STAFF/PLAYER SUSPENSIONS

Any player or staff currently serving suspensions must be indicated on the game sheets in the usual manner. This information is to be placed in the area where the signature would normally go (eg Serving 2 of 3)

### PICK UP PLAYERS

For each pickup player used in a tournament, a team must:

- (a) Disclose in writing on the official game sheet that the player is a pickup player; and
- (b) Present the Tournament Host with a "Pick up Consent" form signed by the official contact of her team authorizing her to be a pickup for the specific tournament.

A team may use a maximum of three (3) pick up players from:

- (i) A lower category of the same age division,
- (ii) Lower category and/or lower age division, same category or lower,

to bring the total team strength up to, but not to exceed the number of registered players on the team.

The OWHA Pick Up Player for Tournament Form must be utilized and must be handed in when registering team at headquarters prior to team's first game.

No pick up players permitted following team's first game of tournament.

#### **PHOTOS**

Photos can be taken OFF THE ICE (if time constraints) or ON ICE as close to boards as possible. Spectators are NOT permitted on the ice to take photos.

## DRESSING ROOMS

Ensure your dressing room is left clean when exiting within 25 minutes following game.

### EARLY GAME START UP

Games can start up to 30-minutes before any scheduled game. Please ensure your team is ready.

### GAME SHEET SIGN IN AT IROQUOIS PARK

There will be two game sheet sign-in tables at Iroquois. For Pads 1-3, it will be located outside Pad #3. For Pads 4-6, it will be across from Pad #4.

#### **GAME SHEETS & LABELS**

Game sheets have been pre-printed for all preliminary games.

We will print labels for semi final and final games.

All players and bench staff in all divisions EXCEPT NOVICE must sign EVERY game sheet.

For the NOVICE teams, the head coach must sign the game sheet verifying players and bench staff.

If a bench staff's name is not listed on the OWHA Official Team Roster or USA Hockey roster, then they cannot go behind the bench.

The Tournament Committee reserves itself the final word on the interpretation of the rules.
